- The said plant will be established on Design, Build and Transfer (DBOOT) basis without any financial assistance from the Municipal Corporation Jaipur or the State government.
- 2. Contractor is required to start the construction work within one month of the land allotment and issue of the letter and commission the common facility within six months failing which the land allotted shall be treated as automatically cancelled.
- 3. Establishment of common bio-medical waste treatment facility (CBMWTF) is to be done within 12 months on land available with the authority.
- 4. The contractor shall submit PERT chart /construction program, detailed development plan as per agreement regarding implementation of the project to the employer and the competent authority that shall monitor the progress of the project according to the program given by the contractor from time to time. Unreasonable unjustifiable delay may be considered as a breach of terms and condition for the contract.
- 5. Day to day work should be carried out as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender document and the agreement. All required technical staff and manpower for the plant and this work as per R.F.P. and norms will be provided by the company.
- Establishment of Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facility, Cleaning of vehicles, safety
 measures, disposal of ashes etc. all work to be carried out as per CPCB guidelines and Bio
 Medical handling and management rules 1998, 2016 and any amendments thereto.
- After successful operation of the plant for 1 Year, increase of 3% on basic rates for every year of successful operation will be admissible i.e. after 1 year basic rate plus 3% of basic rates.
- 8. All relevant and concerned norms, guidelines, direction instruction and legislation issued from time to time by the state government of the central government or by competent authority agency/department, shall have to follow by the contractor in up gradation, installation and operation of plan for the purposes.
- 9. The contractor is expected to upgrade the technology from time to time at his own cost if required under any legislation or order of state government/central government or any other legal/binding direction form competent authority and the technology shall be got approved from the RSPCB by the entrepreneur.
- Company shall strictly adhere to RFP, Concession Agreement conditions, addendum and corrigendum and work plan and all tender documents, technical proposal, financial proposal



submitted by the company. Contractor will strictly follow all the relevant statutory provisions and Acts/ rules including RTPP Act 2012 & RTPP rules 2013.

All conditions of original bid document including addendum and agreement signed between parties and direction of state government, CPCB and RSPCB will be applicable
